Notes

- If any music (including recorded music) is used in a wedding or funeral service, the Organist is legally entitled to his fee, whether he is asked to play or not.
- If a video recording is made, the Organist is entitled to a further 100% of his charge for playing, making his fee £240 for weddings and £210 for funerals. A licence to film costs a further £70.
- For Blessings at the time of marriage, no fee is payable to the DBF, nor a fee charged for the calling of banns or certificates, otherwise the fees are as set out above.
- Travel expenses for the Officiant for funerals are calculated on estimated mileage in each individual case.

Parochial Fees are prescribed by Parliament and published by the Archbishops' Council of the Church of England in its annual *Table of Parochial Fees*. Additional charges are levied by the Parochial Church Council in respect of heating, cleaning, the services of a verger, music, bells and flowers.
